Rowland Encore Grant Guidelines

A Rowland Encore Grant (REG) is open to all Rowland Fellows who have completed the first two years of their fellowship work. The purpose of the REG is to provide a regional shared leadership opportunity to a team of 4-5 Fellows each year to advance the work and mission of The Rowland Foundation. It is understood that only groups of Rowland Fellows who have a serious commitment to a clearly identified, common project leading to a concrete product should apply for a REG.

November 1st - December 31st is the application window for submitting REG proposals each year. All REG applications will be submitted to the Executive Director who will present the year's proposals to the Board of Trustees for consideration at their February meeting. The selection will be based on the team's vision for the proposal, specifically its potential for regional or statewide impact, its feasibility with the time and resources available, the timeliness of the initiative, and the degree to which it advances the mission and work of The Rowland Foundation.

The Rowland Foundation currently budgets \$25,000 for one Rowland Encore Grant to be awarded each year. All prospective REG teams will be informed of the Board's selection decision by March 1st. If not selected, REG teams are welcome to update and resubmit proposals the following year.

The REG program operates on a one-year cycle. Each REG team will convene for a full week at a site of their choosing for in-depth writing, planning, or design work, then deliver their final work product by the end of the year. The Rowland Encore Grant calendar is as follows:

The Board of Trustees will consider grant requests with total budgets of up to \$25,000, with each Rowland Fellow on the REG team receiving a \$3,000 stipend for the summer week of teamwork and the subsequent work required to complete the team's final product. The remainder of the grant is to cover the cost of accommodations, meals, supplies, and resources related to dissemination of the work. Grant applications that present a detailed plan for how the team can have a meaningful impact on Vermont public schools will be given priority. Teams who receive a REG award will document the impact of their work with publicly published products or by recording their REG event(s) in photos, videos, or other media.

REG Team members will each receive the \$3,000 stipend upon submitting the final version of their work product(s) and a complete and updated financial report. If the REG Team has funds remaining after completion of the work, they will submit an updated financial report at the end of each calendar year until all funds have been used.
